- les goûts, les besoins : I <u>like</u> chocolate and I <u>love</u> cakes but I <u>don't like</u> fish and I <u>hate</u> pizza.

I <u>need</u> a lot of love to be happy.

<u>- un futur programmé :</u> Mon avion décolle à 10h30 et atterit à 15h15 : *My plane <u>takes off</u> at 10.30am and <u>lands</u> at 3.15pm.*
