RORY GALLAGHER BLUES



- He was born on March 2nd, 1948, in Ballyshannon, County Donegal, Ireland.
 - He played the guitar, the bass, the mandolin, the saxophone, the sitar, the harmonica, the banjo, the dulcimer, the dobro and he sang.
 - He never married and had no children.
 - At age nine, Rory Gallagher received his first guitar.
 - He won talent contest aged 12. He used the prize money to buy his first electric guitar.
 - Rory Gallagher formed his first band at 13.
 - Rory Gallagher's albums have sold over 30 million copies worldwide.
 - In 1972, Rory Gallagher became famous thanks to "Live in Europe".
 - He died on June 14th 1995, aged 47 years old, in London, Royaume-Uni, complications following a liver transplant.
 - He was buried in St Oliver cemetery, Carrigrohane, Ireland.

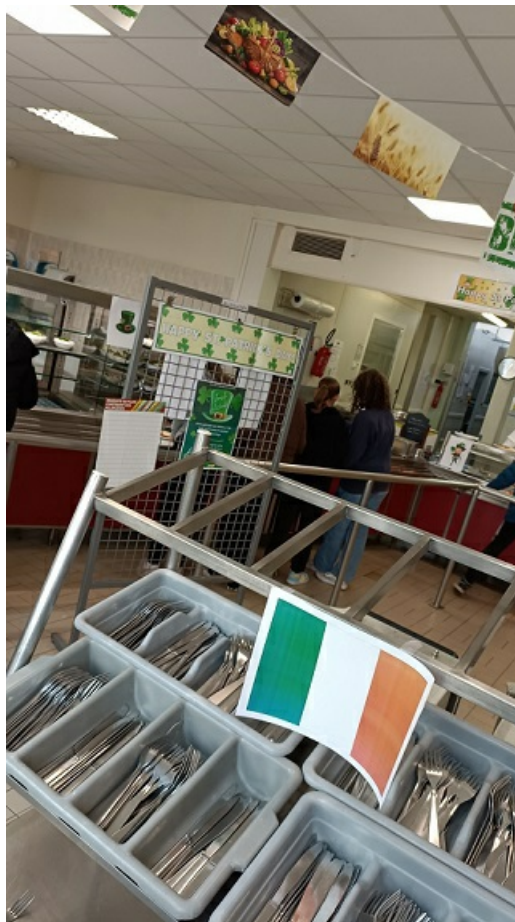


The symbols of St Patrick:
