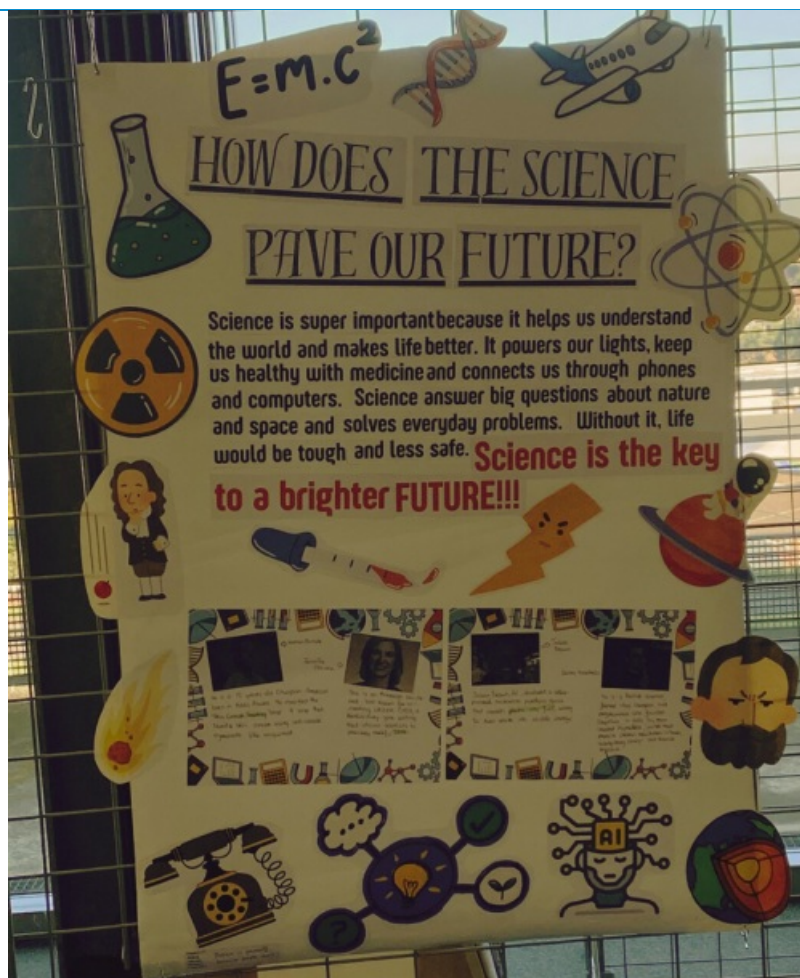




Visite au Lycée Marguerite de Valois
